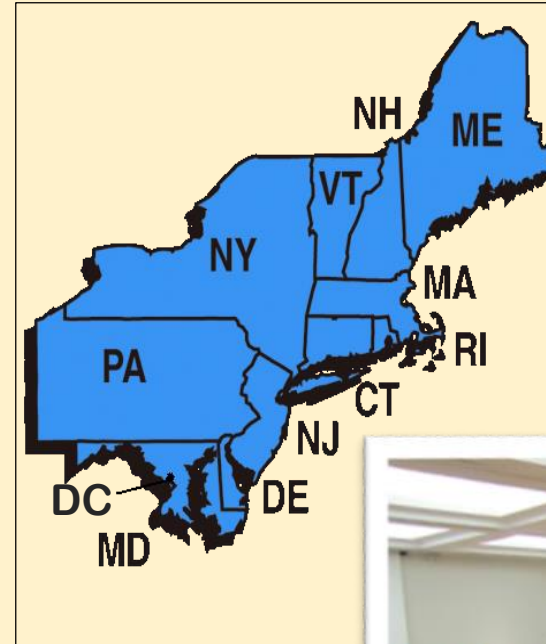

- Working together to reduce energy use and GHG emissions from the transportation sector

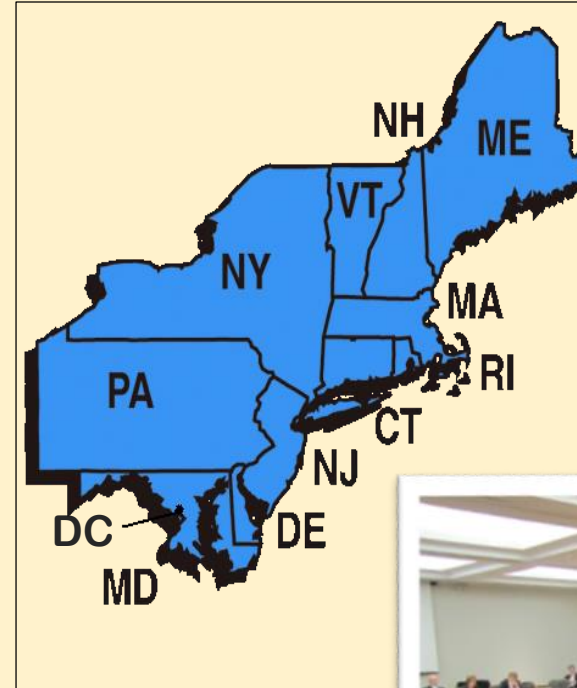

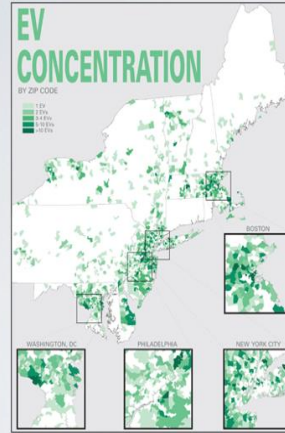

Ten states from Massachusetts to Maryland are joining forces to promote electric vehicles. The Northeast Electric Vehicle Network announced Wednesday it will work to help plan and install charging stations throughout the region as well as attract private investment in clean vehicle infrastructure.

Among the things network members will work on: the location of charging stations. Placing charging stations at commuter rail stations, for example, would allow commuters to park and plug, said Vicki Arroyo, executive director of ...

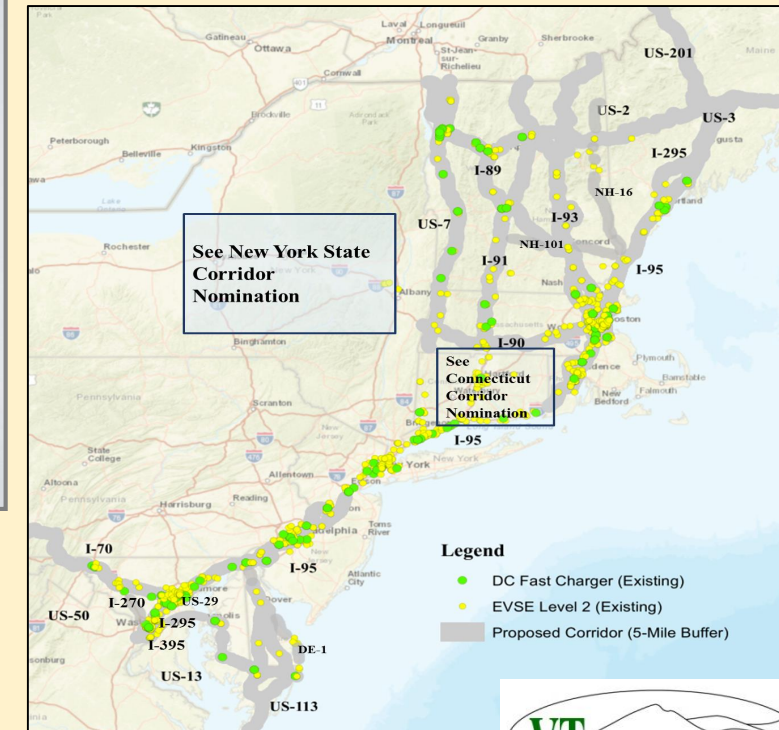

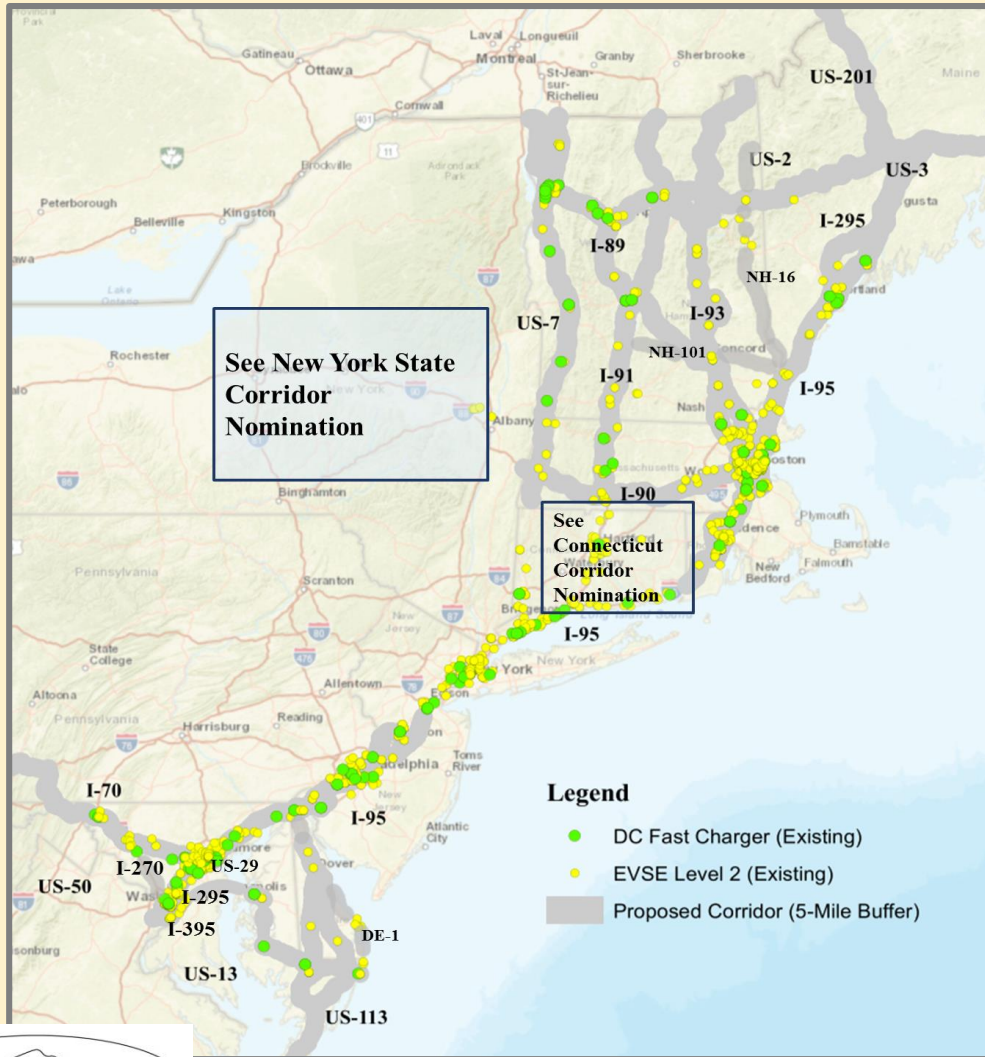
## EV Corridor Nomination



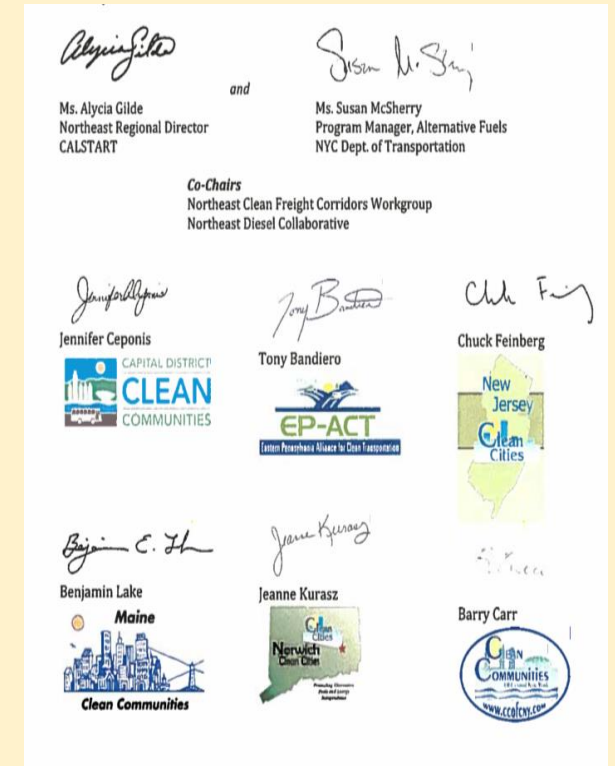
- Legend**

# The Northeast Electric Vehicle Corridor Nomination: Connecting the Region's Major Metro Areas



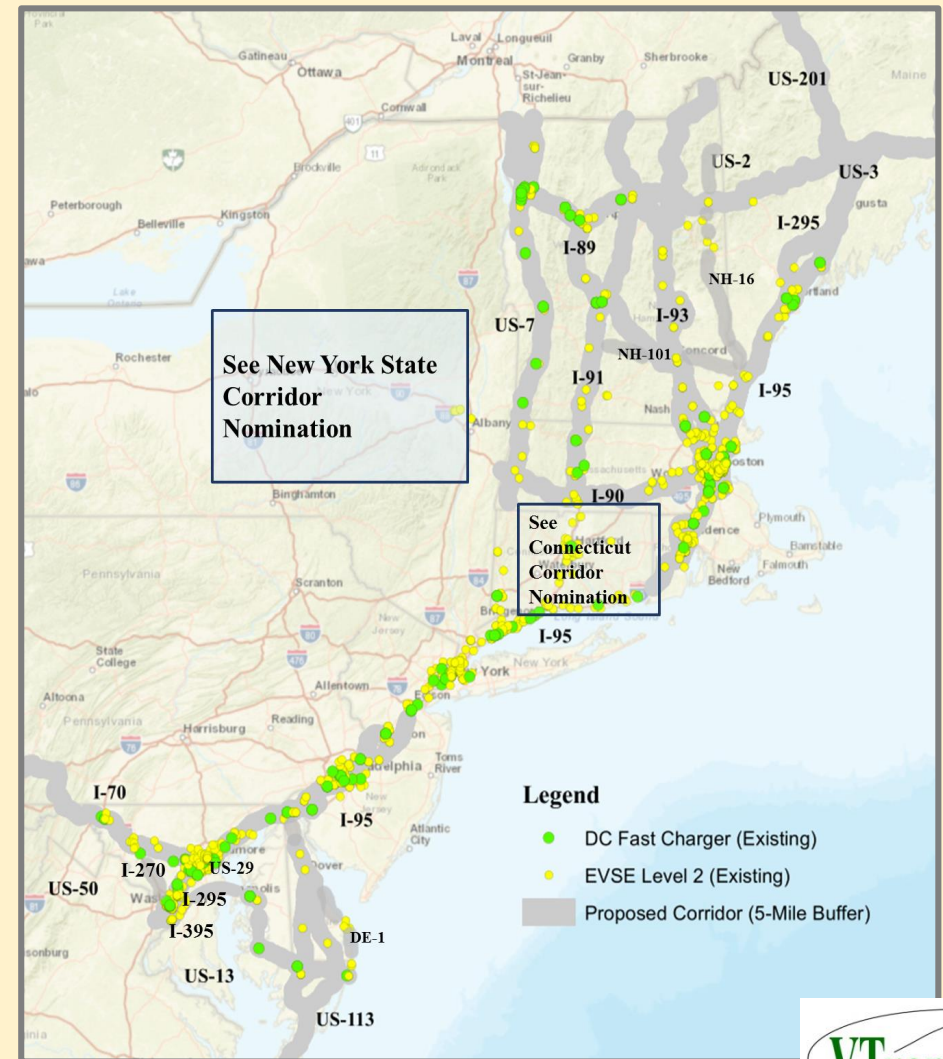
