

- Survey of property owners and businesses helped establish new set of stakeholders.
- Public is very supportive of EV corridor work.
- Need to look at electricity factors, load capacity and rates, at each DCFC potential site.
- Electrify America site selection.
- Speaking a common language, is a common barrier.
- Prepare for outreach on ALL alternative fuel types over longer term.
