Legislative/ Regulatory Support



- 2017 Nevada Legislation
 - Senate Bill 145
 - Electric Vehicle Infrastructure
 Demonstration Program
 - Sec 1.4 (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that it is the policy of this State to expand and accelerate the deployment of electric vehicles and supporting infrastructure throughout this State
- \$15 Million set aside
 - Prioritizes programs that help to complete the Nevada Electric Highway corridor



Overview

- Targeting a complete "electric highway" by the end of 2020.
- 14 sites along I-15, I-80, US 95, US
 50 as a part of NEH Phase two.
- NV Energy will incent up to \$500,000 towards each site
- GOE has allocated \$937K and will incent up to 25% of the actual costs for each site (until the cap is met)
- Minimum of one DC Fast Charger (>= 50kW) and one additional charger (L2 or DCFC)



Call for Action



- Competitive Bid Process
 - Request for Proposals
 - Unit pricing
- Incentive distribution at 2 stages
 - Pre-Construction Task Order
 - Construction Task Order
- Utility line extension upgrades are paid directly from the incentive program

Progress



- Site selection completed for six (6) sites
- Design is in progress for three (3) sites
- Construction is completed for one (1) site
